Before or after the class lecture, the student will use the T.H.I.E.V.E.S. system to summarize the information in the textbook, writing out vocabulary words and definitions, and answering the questions in the back of the chapter, rewriting the questions incorporated into the answer. If the student has any questions from the textbook or lecture notes they need to ask the instructor to expand upon in the next lecture, they can write those in the specific page for that purpose. If the instructor provides specific sources, references, or citations in class, the student can note those on the same page. The pages are placed 'oddly' in the layout of the book. This enables the student to open the notebook and have in-class lecture notes face the summary page to avoid having to flip the pages back and forth for information.
